Animals are moving east from seven Mile to Madison Junction and the splitting and moving north or south.

This week: 30 animals in lower bear Trap----will haze these animals today--permission to go thru bear enclosure east of Duck Creek has been obtained.; ~ 12 bulls around the Stennitt property; 25 head on Galanis property. Single Bull on South Fork is now unhazable and will be probably lethally removed. DOL asked about possibility of capturing unhazable groups and hauling animals into the Park. YNP will check.

Bulls, cows reported in Gardiner Basin are returning to the park.

FS: Need to give FS-West a heads up befor a hazing op on FS. Would prefer any lethal removal not to be on FS.
